



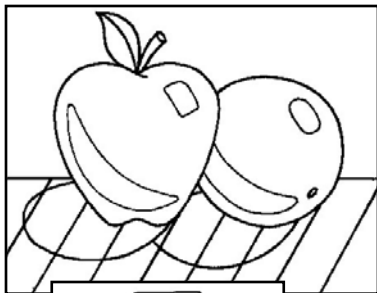
REGISTRATION is available for the FALL session!

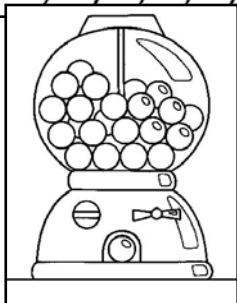
Young Rembrandts Lesson Summary



APPLE/ORANGE

We'll create a still life drawing of an apple and an orange. This lesson provides great instruction to illustrating inanimate objects. It is also a great introduction to understanding light and shadow. The use of shading gives our drawing a sense of depth and volume.

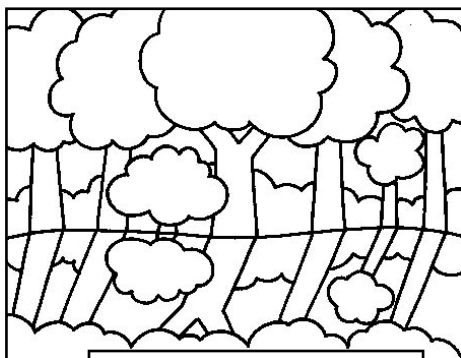
Applying what you've learned: Still life drawings are great practice for coloring and shading. Can you create a new still life drawing that features different fruits?



GUMBALL MACHINE

Draw a colorful gumball machine. This illustration provides plenty of practice for drawing circles and curved lines. This detailed composition also teaches us how to overlap multiple objects. We also discuss how shiny objects have highlights that reflect light.

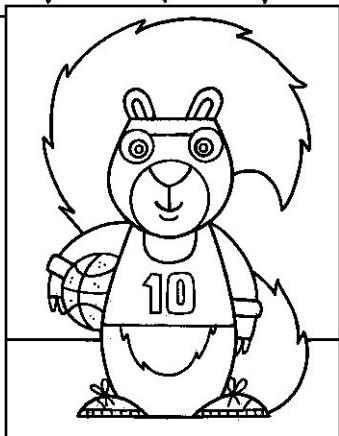
Applying what you've learned: Drawing overlapping, repeating shapes helps us focus and teaches us to be patient. Can you redraw and recolor your gumball machine?



FALL SCENE

In keeping with the season, we draw this colorful fall scene. Our composition depicts a peaceful forest. Our vibrant trees with their thick trunks produce heavy shadows on the ground below them. The use of fall colors reinforce the seasonal theme of our drawing.

Applying what you've learned: Seasonal colors are wonderful. Can you draw a summer scene that incorporates summer colors?



SILLY SQUIRREL

We'll draw this silly squirrel. We learn how to personify an ordinary squirrel, transforming it into a fully-realized cartoon character. We also personalize our squirrel with clothing and accessories. Bright, vibrant colors enhance our cartoon-like drawing.

Applying what you've learned: Transforming ordinary animals into cartoon characters is a great drawing exercise. Can you create more cartoon characters from other animals?

Your child will learn these skills and techniques during Young Rembrandts' classes. Each week your child draws new images, learns new vocabulary and has fun discovering art and the Power of Drawing!

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
